## PE News

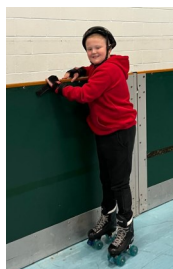
Year 3 children went to Northampton Academy this week to take part in multisports activities lead by the Northampton Academy Young Leaders.
