Vocabulary		Map of the World with Continents and Oceans	Where our food comes from in the UK
<b>Continent</b>	A continent is a very large area of land, such as Africa or Asia, that consists of several countries.		
<b>Reared</b>	If you rear a young animal, you keep and look after it until it is old enough to be used for food.		
<b>Imported</b>	Goods or products brought in from another country in order to be sold		
<b>Exported</b>	To sell products to another country.		
<b>Harvest</b>	The gathering of a crop.		
<b>Processed</b>	Food can be treated or prepared by a special method.

<b>Food Miles</b>	<p>A unit used to measure the distance that food travels - from where it is produced, to where it is eaten.</p> 	 <p><a href="https://www.foodmiles.com/">https://www.foodmiles.com/</a></p>	<p><b>Key Knowledge</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The seven continents are: Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Oceania (sometimes called Australia)</li> <li>• The five oceans are: Pacific, Indian, Atlantic, Arctic and Southern Ocean.</li> <li>• Asia is the largest continent and Oceania (Australia) is the smallest.</li> <li>• The distance travelled is referred to as food miles.</li> </ul>
