

Vocabulary

Era	A period of time in history. An era often begins or ends with an important event.
Catholic	A Catholic is a Christian with different beliefs to Protestant Christians. Catholic Christianity was the main religion in Europe in the time of the Tudors.
Protestant	A protestant is a Christian with different religious beliefs to Catholic Christians. Throughout history these two religious groups have had many conflicts.
Line of succession	The order in which individuals are expected to succeed one another as the monarch




William Shakespeare  
1564- 1616

William Shakespeare was an actor and playwright who lived and worked in London and Stratford upon Avon during the reign of Elizabeth I.

William was born around 23<sup>rd</sup> April 1564 and died on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 1616.

Heir	A person who inherits and continues the work of the person before them		During his lifetime, William wrote 37 plays, many of which were performed at the Globe Theatre in London.

Descendant	Someone's descendants are the people in later generations who are related to them	Shakespeare's family	Did you know...?	
Legacy	Something which is the direct result of a person a time or an event and continues to exist after it.	Shakespeare was married to Anne Hathaway and had 3 children: Susanna, Hamnet and Judith.	Shakespeare's granddaughter Elizabeth lived in Abington Manor (now Abington Museum) with her husband. She is buried in the church next door to the manor.
